

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

CARING FOR YOUR MIRROR

CLEANING

Light staining like dust or water drops can be easily removed with a soft and dry cloth. If there is heavy staining please perform wet cleaning. For wet cleaning, please use clear and lukewarm water with a soft cloth. Recommended concentrates are denaturated alcohol as well as diluted bioalcohol.

WATER RESIDUES

At all times, the mirror edges need to be free of water droplets. This holds especially for mirrored cabinets, framed mirrors and adjoining mirrors since their narrow gaps might encourage water residues near the edges. Therefore, please keep in mind to dry the edges all around the mirror or the mirrored cabinet. A misty mirror should be dried immediately via wiping off or precise ventilation.

INAPPROPRIATE CLEANING AGENTS

Mirrors consist of a glass panel with one silver coating and several varnish coatings. The silver is responsible for the reflection. In case of mirrors and mirrored cabinets, the silver coating is not protected and hence directly exposed to influences from the outside. Reasons for changes on the mirror often result from effects on the mirror edge or the coatings, for example by:

- Cleaning with inappropriate cleaning agents
- Vapours from solvents and cleaning agents as well as room fragrance products
- Water droplets which were not removed immediately
- A moist environment and not enough ventilation
- Possible damages during assembly
- The alkalinity of the masonry in connection with moisture

Glass cleaning products might contain maintaining or chemical components or odorants. The following cleaning agents are unsuitable:

- WC or bathroom cleaners
- Heavily chlorinated tap water
- Scrubbing sponges with or without cleaning additives
- Cosmetic cleaning products
- Vinegar and vinegar based cleaners
- Microfibre cloths
- Liquid ammonia
- Strong descalers

STORAGE IN MIRRORED CABINETS

Since mirrored cabinets are pieces of furniture it is possible to store many utensils for daily hygiene/cosmetic as well as cleaning products for your bathroom. Please keep in mind that some products are aggressive, e.g. nail polish remover or pipe cleaner, and therefore should never be left open! Dangerous vapours might leak, which lead to damages on the mirrored doors, handles and the aluminium corpus.
